*** For UG and PG programme there shall be one supernumerary seat each for Wards Defence personnel/ Exservicemen and persons of J&K domicile in addition to the normal intake.**

*** Reservation of seats for OBC/SC/ST/PWD candidates will be as per Govt of India norms**
