Unit-I: Social Work Profession: Meaning & concept; History; Social Work Ideologies; Social Work Values; Social Work Profession; Social Work Theories : empowerment theory, social development theory, Human rights theory, Social Justice Theory, Strength-based theory, Socio-ecological theory, Social movement theory;
